Minutes Conservation Commission Thursday, March 26, 2015 7:00pm

Bid Review - Environmental impact of Pipeline on Town Conservation Land.

Tad Putney – Town Administrator also here in attendance for this meeting. Drew Kellner was also in the audience.

Tad handed out a summary of the bids he had received from four different companies and explained that he requested information from 5 companies and they had only received 4 proposals back. His summary includes columns for scope of work covered in bid, age of firm, Comprehensive scope detail, Other suggestions, Cost of job, timing of job, how many meetings/presentations they feel will be needed, references, staffing, and any comments. Moosewood is already doing a similar project for the town of Merrimack. They said it would cut down on the travel expenses if they are already heading to this general area. They have also suggested that they attend 3+ meeting. **Tad** said the town could benefit from an introductory meeting with this company. **Jordan** said they have also offered to do the entirety of the lots and not just the requested 150 ft around the proposed placement of the pipeline. **Buddy** said Meridian Land Services came in at a much lower proposal and they already know the area well. After a lengthy discussion about all four companies and what they would provide for the Town the Board agreed that Moosewood Ecological LLC.

Jordan made a motion to recommend that the Selectboard hire Moosewood Ecological LLC with a cap of \$14,980 to perform the scope of work as proposed along with soil sampling to be done onsite vs digital mapping. Tom seconded. Vote yes 4-0.

Alternate Member Nomination

Buddy made a motion to recommend to the Selectboard that Drew Kellner (Yankee Way) be appointed as an alternate on the Conservation Commission with a term expiring in March of 2018. Tom Seconded. Vote yes 4-0.
