Tom said Alex Hadley is in need for an Eagle Scout Project. He is 14 years old and he would like to make a kiosk. **Alex** explained how he would go about building the kiosk Plans Attached). **Tom** said they would need to figure out a location to put these new kiosks. **Tom** signed the Eagle Scout paperwork's for Alex to get started.

Filming Animal Adventures at Talbot Taylor Sanctuary

Buddy said he had a call from someone from Lunenburg Massachusetts who would like to film an Animal Adventure show at the Talbot Taylor Wildlife Sanctuary. He would like it to include the history of the sanctuary. **Jordan** said she will be available to discuss the wildlife at this location. **Buddy** said Dave Pease has offered to film this.

Eastman Development Subdivision J-16

In attendance for this meeting is Randy Haight with Meridian Land Services Inc. **Randy** said he just wanted clarification that the Conservation Commission would agree to hold a Conservation Easement Deed over the wetland area of lot J-16-11, J-16-10, and J-16-9 on the Easement Development Subdivision. This is contagious with the open space lot J-24-33 from the Wildwood subdivision. The Board reviewed the easement wording. They agreed they would be interested in the Easement Deed to the

Conservation Commission for these lots. Jay made a motion to accept the Conservation Easement as proposed by Phil Chandler for lots J-16-11, J-16-10, and J-16-9. Tom seconded. Vote yes 5-0.

Bennet Chandler is willing to guide the BCC through the trail off Wildwood Drive they would just need to reach out to him to set up a date and time.

Trails - Mud Season (Buddy)

Buddy said Hollis has closed the trails for mud season and people come to the Brookline trails because we do not close them. **Jay** said they should appoint someone make that determination. **Drew** said they will also need to figure out which trail entrances to mark with closed signs. We will also need figure out where to post and what are we closing the trails to walkers, mountain bikes, equestrian etc. **Buddy** suggested they add this to the next agenda and make a plan at the next meeting. The Board agreed to close the Cliff trail off to foot traffic only.

Canoe Trip down the Nissitissit River

Jordan said the canoe trip on May 6th, 2018 went well they had some difficulties getting around some of the downed trees. But other than that it went well. They had started out behind the fire station and it took about two hours. There were about 14 boats. **Buddy** said for the 250th anniversary of Brookline next year he would like to make this canoe trip and event along with some hikes.

Brendan said the Selectboard is looking to reestablish the Melendy Pond Committee.

Lake Host Program

Brendan said they have been issued the grant for \$2,500 for the lake host payroll this year.


