- March minutes were read and accepted.
- The Board of Fire Engineers talked with Lt/Inspector J P Royea. Chief Corey left the room.
- The 2019 budget is going well. We will get three bids on the painting of the fire station.
- Discussion of personnel: One of our Lieutenants is moving away in June. The Board voted to post the lieutenant job, so it can be filled by June or July.
- We are going to put crushed gravel around the newly paved water holes. We are going to do some graveling and grading on some other ones. We will pave three more this year.
- Bingham's needs to buy other half of the cistern and then it will be put in.
- Lee Lemoine is going to fix our fire horn.
- Discussion on purchase of new Fire Apparatus. We have three trucks 30 years old or older. We have one 24 years old and one 17 years old. The pickup's frame is starting to rust. The plan is to replace the pickup when the Command SUV is paid off. All the rescue tools have been purchased. The Brookline Fire Association has purchased the Combi Tool for 5E3 at \$9,695.00. The Forestry grant PPE has been ordered. We will be buying new boiler at end of year. Next year we start to replace our second set of gear.
- A training SOG has been written up. Training is going very well.
- Signing of bills.
