- We can get our physicals now and will see if an applicant is still interested. Fire Classes are starting back up, and we have four members taking them.
- Our training is going fine and we will continue until we can all meet at same time.
- We will be buying some rope equipment, to replace out of date equipment. We will start purchasing gear as several sets are going to be out of date by the end of the year.
