Subdivision Application

The following is a list of the waivers requested and justification.

Waiver Request #1 – Section 4.6.05f of the Brookline, NH Subdivision Regulations

The applicant request relief from Section 4.6.05f.:

If utility company(s) requires an easement to provide service, no final approval shall be granted by the Board until such easements are secured. Also, a letter of intent to provide service from the utility company(s) must accompany the application

To allow relief from the submittal requirement.

Justification

A letter of intent to provide service from the utility company(s) shall be included in the application prior to the final submission.
