- Current budget is going well. Payroll for call firefighters will end on November 30, 2017. Our next budget hearing will be the public hearing in January.
- Radios should be up and running by sometime in January.
- Scott Brooks has finished the Cleveland Hill water hole and it looks great. Next year we will pave Cleveland Hill, Mountain Rd. and Bumpus on Old Milford Rd.
- Personnel was discussed.
- The roof ramp project has begun and should be done in a few weeks.
- Training was discussed and is going well.
- Some insurance companies are looking at our 8B rating to see how much this could save us.
- Our new air packs that were bought with the grant money have been purchased and put in service.
- We have been awarded the 2018 Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant.
- We worked with Brookline Ambulance to secure a grant for Active Shooter Equipment.
- Bills were signed.
