- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Santuccio, Dave Flannery, Dave Joki and Chief Corey were present.
- Dave Flannery didn't have November minutes. They will be read at next meeting.
- The 2018 budget is going according to schedule. The Board voted to go with Amkus Rescue System, it was \$20,000.00 cheaper. The Board voted to buy the new rescue tools for 5R1. We will try to get 5R2 rescue tools by year end. We withdrew the warrant article for 2019, for the new 5P1. The board noted that we still need it, but this was the wrong year to ask with taxes going up so much.
- After using the command SUV at a few fire calls, we need a 110 plug in the rear and a phone charger.
- We have two new applicants that need background checks and physicals. One new applicant has passed the background check and physical.
- The Active Shooter Training is set for January 26, 2019 with Police and EMS. It will be held at the RMMS School.
- Discussion on Bingham Lumber installing and hooking up the cistern.
- Discussion of new water boiler. It was brought up about a holding tank like Milford and Amherst have. We will be getting more information on holding tank. With two fires back to back it took two weeks to boil off all the water.
- We got the West Hill Rd. water hole paved.
- We added two new SOPs and finished the SOGs. We have a new job description for new members.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm and next meeting on January 14, 2019 at 7:00 pm.
