- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Santuccio, Dave Flannery, Dave Joki, Glenn Davis and Chief Corey were present.
- Glenn Davis from Lakes Region Fire Apparatus, Inc. was in to talk about our new pumper truck.
- November minutes were read and accepted.
- It was voted to purchase I Am Responding and order the remaining gear to finish this up by year end. Town budget hearings are on January 16, and 17.
- Radios should be up and running by mid-January.
- Discussion on new personnel taking Level I in Jaffrey, starting in January. Two members will be attending.
- One other new applicant is getting a background check.
- We will be trying out Holmatro Rescue Tools on December 18, at 7:00 pm.
- Discussion on Bingham Lumber installing and hooking up the cistern.
- We have received a map detailing five driving miles from the Fire station. It covers the whole town. The Nashua Regional Planning Commission is working on this map. The rate for being within five driving miles of the Fire station is 8B.
- Chief Corey asked if the Board of Fire Engineers would be interested in a water hole on his property for covering the center of town. This would come at no cost to the town. They voted yes.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 9:00 pm and next meeting on January 9, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
