<u>Minutes</u> <u>Board of Fire Engineers</u> <u>Monday, December 12, 2016</u>

- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Flannery, Dave Santuccio, Dave Joki, Chief Corey and firefighter Joe Delpapa were present.
- Personnel was discussed and Joe Delpapa left the meeting.
- November minutes were read and accepted.
- Ball Hill radio tower is ready to go and Big Bear is still being negotiated to put the equipment on the cell tower.
- The carpet in the offices and conference room is done. The stairs and landing are also done in rubber tile.
- The Select Board gave the Fire Department enough money to buy 15 sets of gear at \$1,947.74 each and total cost of \$29,216.10. The gear has been ordered.
- We finished mowing all the water holes. Darrell Pelletier finished mowing water holes with his tractor.
- The Fire Association has purchased a gear dryer for the Fire Department. The Board of Fire Engineers thanked the Fire Association for that purchase.
- The budget was discussed.
- 5E2 is out of service. It has a leaking pipe and is going to Valley Fire Equipment to get fixed.
- We will meet with Bulldog Fire Apparatus on January 18, 2017 at 7:00 pm.
- The following items have been ordered under the 2016 budget: Thermal Imaging Camera, 4 Personal CO detectors, Hydrogen Cyanide meter, Four Gas Meter, 600 ft. 5" Hose, Air Chisel, 300 ft. of 1 ½ Forestry Hose, Chain Saw, Leaf Blower, Brush Cutter and Carpet Cleaner.
- All bills for 2016 have to be in by January 6, 2017 at noon.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 9:00 pm.
