<u>Minutes</u> <u>Board of Fire Engineers</u> <u>Monday, May 8, 2017</u>

- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Santuccio, Dave Flannery, Dave Joki were present, as well as Chief Corey and Byron Brooks.
- The Engineers and Chief met with Byron Brooks from KME Fire Apparatus. We are getting prices on the three fire apparatus we will need to purchase in the next seven years. Byron will use our input to draw up plans and determine the cost of each apparatus. He will get back to us in a month.
- April's minutes were read and accepted.
- Radios should be up and running by the end of June. Some equipment is backordered. Beltronics will soon begin the installation of the station radio.
- Two Contractors did not want to submit a bid on the roof ramp and a third contractor is in the process of completing his bid.
- We have a master plan of the fire apparatus and equipment that will be needed over the next seven years. We need a few more prices to complete the plan.
- A Mustang Water suit and Stihl chain saw have been purchased and are on the trucks.
- Air cleaning specialists should have the Plymovent exhaust up and running by the end of July.
- Eight sets of gear are in. A rack to hold the gear is being built downstairs on Wednesday.
- Brookline Ambulance Service is having a class on Mass Casualty Incident Training here at the fire station on May 24, at 7:00 pm.
- No update from ISO.
- Officers and personnel were discussed.
- We are working on the drill at CSDA for June 24, 2017.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 9:00 pm and the next meeting will be held on June 12, 2017 at 7:00 pm.
