- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Santuccio, Dave Flannery, Dave Joki, and Chief Corey were present.
- May minutes were read and accepted.
- The remaining gear has been ordered, and with its delivery we will be up-to-date on all gear.
- We are in possession of the Command SUV. Its plates have been put on, it will be lettered on June 16th, and on June 19th, it will have the lights and siren installed. We should have it for the 4th of July parade.
- Waiting for other bids on water holes to come in.
- The 2018 budget was discussed and is going well.
- Our radio antennas have been backordered and September is the new date for radio work to be completed.
- The addition for antiques will free up some room downstairs, allowing us to put the UTV on the trailer at all times and be under cover during all seasons. The boat could be ready to hook on to the Van.
- No personnel/officer issues at this time.
- Training is going well.
- We will need a new router for the fire station. The computer on which Fire Programs is installed is running slowly. The cost for a new router is \$3406.98. We will have to purchase it either next year or at the end of this year.
- Bingham Lumber will be getting the cistern in mid-June. Shortly after that it will be hooked
 up. The right of way to the river is down on the flat part of the land. They are marked with
 metal posts halfway to the back of the property.
- The Plymovent system will be installed mid-July. The exhaust on the Van needs to be fixed.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 8:30 and next meeting on July 9, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
