Board of Fire Engineers
Monday, July 9, 2018

- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Santuccio, Dave Flannery, Dave Joki, and Chief Corey were present.
- June minutes were read and accepted.
- The new boots and helmets have come in. This brings our gear up to NFPA Standards. In four years, we will have to replace the second set of jackets and pants for all firefighters.
- The new Command SUV should be all equipped by mid-July. The pickup will stay at the station at night and the Inspector will use it during day.
- We will have Champion Paving do the paving on water holes. Scott Tiedemann & Sons Excavation, LLC will dig out the Austin Rd. fire pond.
- The 2018 budget was discussed. We have spent 48% of the budget so far this year.
- Some of the radio equipment that was on backorder has come in. Still waiting on antennas to come in. City of Lawrence has asked to use our radio frequency. The board voted 3-0 not to allow them to use it.
- Still waiting on a few more items related to the addition, for the Select Board to approve.
- We will be going from six companies down to five companies. Shawn Ricard has resigned.
- On September 15, 2018 we will be finishing our Active Shooter Training with the state. The Police and EMS will be working with us. The class is from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm at RMMS.
- Bingham cistern is on-site and will be installed soon.
- The PlymoVent System has been installed. We need to get the electrician in to hook up the panel. Should be up and running in a week.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm and next meeting will be held on August 13, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
