- The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.
- Board of Fire Engineers members Dave Santuccio, Dave Flannery, and Chief Corey were present. Dave Joki was on vacation.
- July minutes were read and accepted.
- We received all our new gear.
- The new Command SUV has been equipped and is being used now.
- Radios should be up and running by mid-September. All the backorder parts have come in.
- The paving on the water holes will take place in mid-October.
- One other new applicant is getting a background check.
- The 2018 budget is going well. Next month we will be fixing the pump on 5E3. We are trying to keep the 2019 budget flat. We asked the Select Board to support the purchase of new 5P1 to replace old 5E4.
- The Engineers will support the antique fire truck addition.
- When it cools down we are going to fix the fire horn.
- We will have an Active Shooter Training on September 15, with EMS and Police at RMMS on Milford St. The NH DOS, Division of Fire Standards, Training & EMS will be putting on this training.
- Still waiting on Bingham Lumber to get the cistern in.
- The Plymovent system is up and running downstairs. This finalizes that cancer prevention project.
- The Board asked to have Lakes Region Fire Apparatus come to the next meeting. KME will come to the October meeting. We are trying to get a final 5E4 price set for Town meeting.
- We went over the CIP plan. If the Select Board is not going to support 5E4, then we will move on to 5E2.
- We are hoping to have the SOGs done in September.
- Bills were signed.
- Meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm and next meeting on September 11, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
