Fire Danger Rating System

Class Day

- Class 1 Low
 - Fires are not likely, it may be raining
- Class 2 Moderate
 - Fires are possible in light fuels, day after a rain
- Class 3 High
 - Fuels in open areas and sunny slopes may spread rapidly
- Class 4 Very High
 - Fires start easily from all causes
 - Fires spread and increase in intensity rapidly
 - Spot fires occur
 - Fire will burn deep, except in the spring
- Class 5 Extreme
 - Fires will spread very rapidly with severe spotting
 - Difficult to extinguish, mop up requires a great deal of effort

A burn permit will not be issued for a High Class 3, 4 or 5
