Approved Minutes

Roy moved, seconded by Louise, to approve the minutes from the Monday, September 9th, 2019 meeting. Voted Yes 5-0.

Book Sales

Sold just under 500 books.

Book Index

We have about \$8k left in appropriated funds. It will cost between \$1,600-\$2,000 for Sid to produce the index. The index will only reference people and places. The estimate to print 500 indexes in paperback is \sim \$2,000. We decided charging \$10 for the index is a fair price.

Roy made a motion to spend up to \$2k to produce the index, up to \$2k to print it, and sell it at \$10. Gail seconded. Voted Yes 5-1. Keith will double check the estimates with Sid.
